While the new Executive Order cancels most pandemic-related restrictions, it also reminds Oregon residents that masks are still required in health care settings, airports, airplanes, and public transportation (Tri-met Lift riders included).

Individuals who are unvaccinated or who are at risk for severe COVID-19 disease need to continue to wear a mask or face covering and maintain physical distancing of at least six (6) feet from other individuals when in crowded areas and in large gatherings of individuals.
